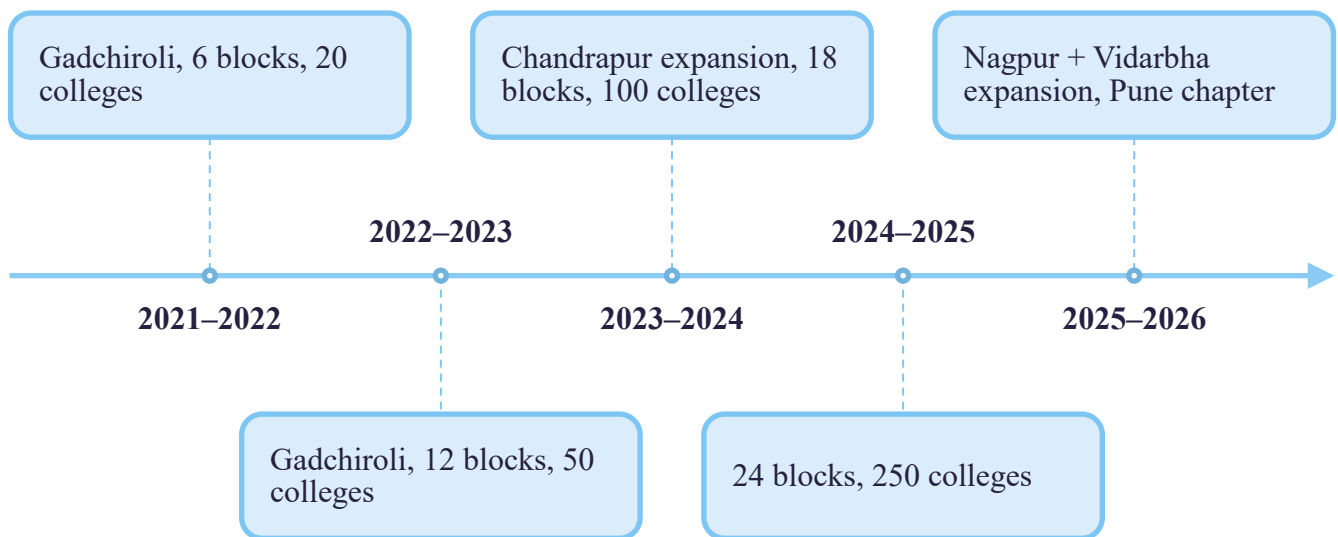

## FUNNEL / FLOW OF STUDENT JOURNEY

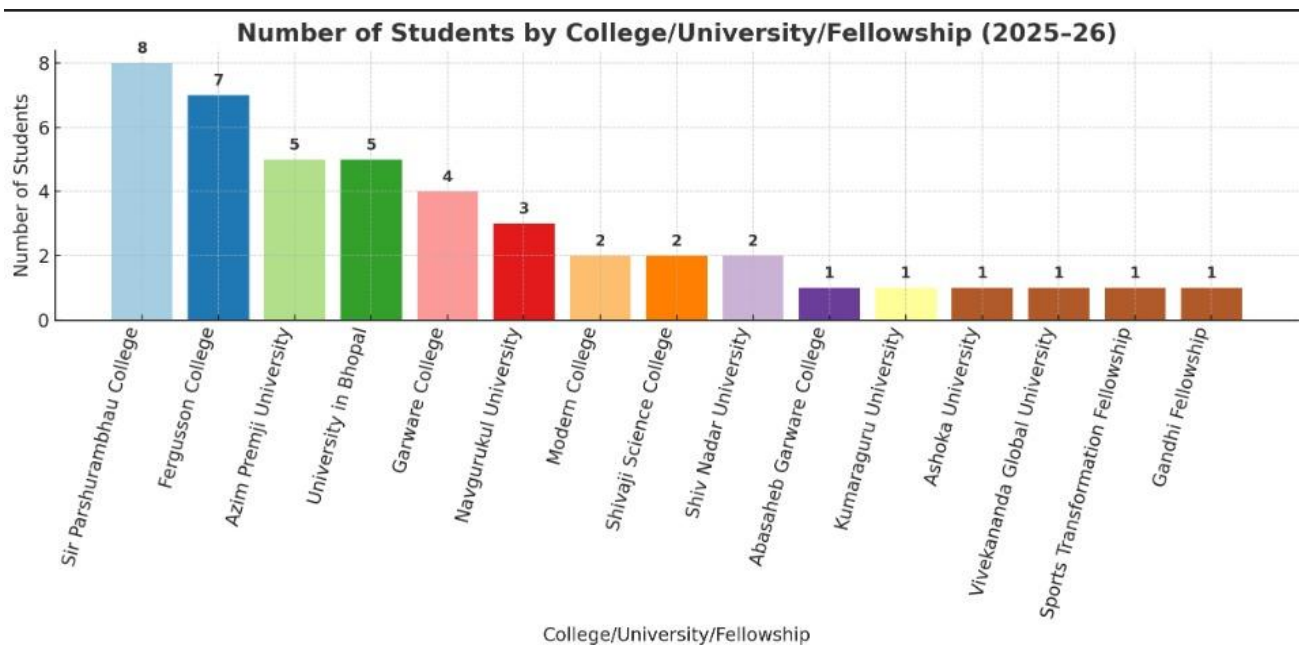

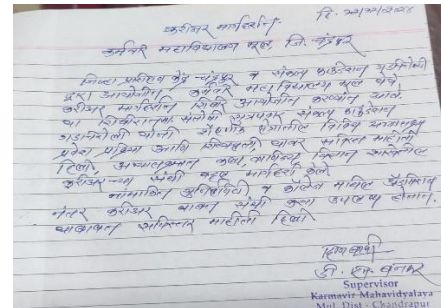

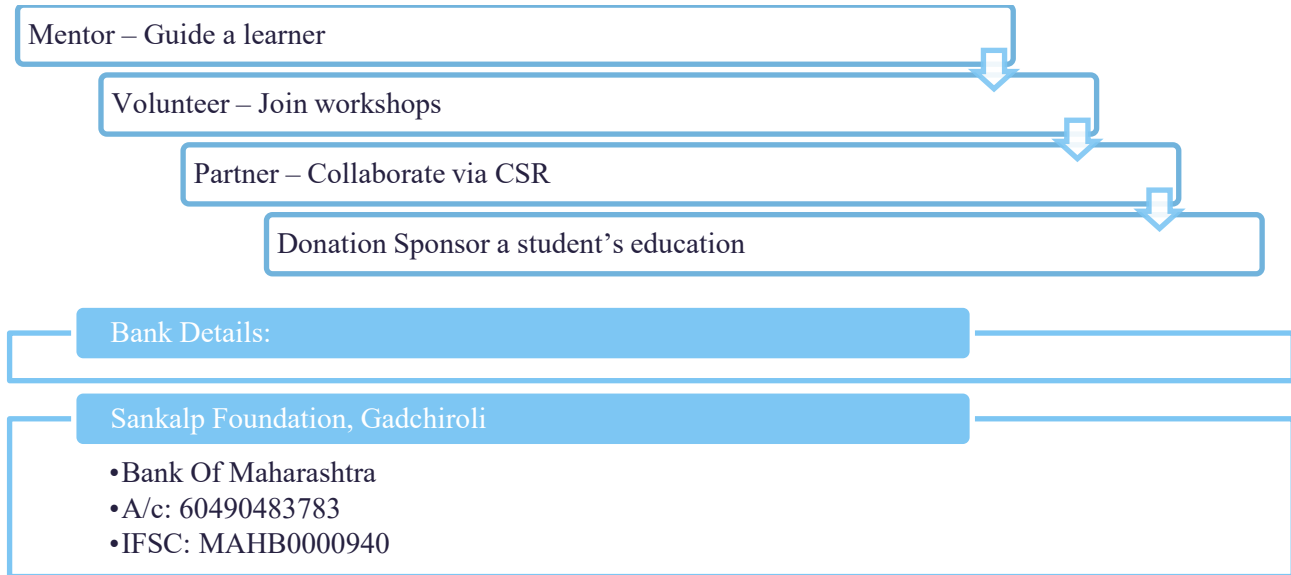
